We are encouraging people to remember a person they know who has died during this pandemic period (regardless of if the death was Covid-19 related or not), by stitching, sewing, drawing or painting their full name onto a square of fabric. We also invite you to write an accompanying page about that person, including text and images. We can receive these physically and digitally. We hope to make the names into an art piece and sew them altogether.

What do I need to do?

It's simple - just stitch, draw or paint the name of the person you'd like to remember onto a piece of fabric.

What size fabric?

Roughly an A5 sized piece of fabric would be great. That's 148 x 210 mm

Then what?

Send us your finished creations and stories via email, and post us your fabric.
